## Proposed Gundagai Pool Tiling & Disabled Ramp Program

Cootamundra—Gundagai Regional Council (CGRC), identified the need of tiling and provision of a Disabled access Ramp in its Gundagai War memorial Swimming Pool.

The War Memorial Swimming Pool which was built in 1950, is the only public swimming pool complex in Gundagai area operated by the Council. Council has recently completed the construction of Gym and Heated pool Redevelopment after securing \$316,242.00 funding from the NSW Government, Department of Trade & Investment, under ClubGRANTS Category 3 Fund.

Due to the age and condition of the pool, it is facing a major leakage of water from the construction joints. The tiling of the pool has been proposed to minimize the water leakage as well as to extend the service life of the pool.

Further, Council has managed to provide a disabled access to the pool via portable staircase; however, this is not permanent in nature and proposes a more permanent type structure which fits in the existing pool with the current Australian/New Zealand standards. Hence, Council further proposes to provide a disabled access ramp to the pool.

Estimated cost for tiling and provision of disabled access to the Gundagai swimming pool at is \$300k










Fig 1.0 Location map-Gundagai War Memorial Swimming Pool Complex
