Proposed Gundagai VIC Redevelopment –Shade Sail, Ramp & Disabled toilet Program

Cootamundra—Gundagai Regional Council (CGRC), identified the need of redevelopment of its Visitor Information Centre with replacement of shade sail and a provision of a disabled toilet and removal of split levels and trip hazards to the coach terminal.

The Gundagai Visitor Information and Travel Centre located at the main Street (Sheridan Street) provides information regarding exploring Gundagai's Architectural Heritage Walk to capture the essence of the historic and fascinating township. Gundagai's best kept secret is Rusconi's Marble Masterpiece on display at the Visitor Centere-20,978 pieces of carved NSW marble taking 28 years to complete.

The office has a good set up of toilet facility and ramp access to the main office, however, there is a lack of these facilities for the coach terminal. This coach terminal is open 24/7 for the visitors travelling from different directions.

Hence, Council proposes to redevelop this VIC basically the coach terminal with the provision of these facilities including the replacement of shade sail, removal of split levels and trip hazards.

The estimated cost of these essential infrastructures is \$300K.
