Proposed Gundagai Netball Courts Upgrade

Cootamundra—Gundagai Regional Council (CGRC), identified a need of upgrade of its Netball Courts located at Gundagai.

The old disused and dilapidated tennis courts (Fig 1.1), which were unsafe and unattractive, were recently upgraded after successfully securing \$25,000 Grant from Office of Communities Sports and Recreation under Club Grants. Council has also a significant contribution including the contribution as cash, labour and volunteer from the local communities to bring up to the present modern multi sports facilities stage (Fig 1.2).

The site was prepared by clearing the vegetation, filling and levelling then compacting the existing clay surface with a road base gravel overlay, supplying and installing underground drainage, supplying and installing a rolled asphalt surface, installing line marking and posts, and establishing electrical lighting and fencing to standard.

Now, this site caters the modern multi sports primarily for netball, basketball, tennis, badminton and handball.

This site is located within Council's existing recreational and swimming pool area, which has the opportunities to share access to facilities such as toilet blocks, canteens, playgrounds, and BBQ's in close proximity. The site is also accessible by all forms of transport including pedestrian and cycling routes.

In order to fully develop this site as recreational, fully functional and used by various sports groups more effectively, there is an urgent need of upgrade of the some of the prominent facilities like electrical lighting, shelter and storage facilities. Council proposes to fund this out of \$9M Major Projects Program.

Estimated cost of upgrade of Gundagai Netball Courts Upgrade is

\$200K
