This new piece of equipment will enhance and improve the current state of the course and in particular the putting greens. Course Superintendent Tim Ryan says the new Turf Tender will give a better quality cut and hopefully encourage more people to play on this beautiful course.

In prime condition the course has a very good reputation and attracts many visitors who "stay and play". CGRC Administrator Stephen Sykes said "boosting visitor numbers to local tourist attractions and businesses alike can only be of advantage to our region".

With only two full time employees, the club relies on volunteer labour to assist with the maintenance and upkeep of the course. "The new equipment is easier for volunteers to use and easier to teach them how to use it." Tim said.

With less break down time and reliability increased, time is now better utilised improving other areas around the course.
