CAMP DRAFT AREA UP GRADE AT GUNDAGAI RODEO GROUNDS.

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE.

Work has commenced on the camp draft arena at the Gundagai rodeo grounds. Rodeo club members have held working bees to dismantle the old post and wire fencing in preparation for new steel fencing around the perimeter of the arena.

The Gundagai Rodeo Club were successful in gaining a grant of \$25,000 from the Stronger Communities Fund, an initiative of the NSW State Government and administered by Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council. The grant will assist the club in erecting 405 metres of steel fencing, which includes five bull rails and five gates.

The Gundagai Rodeo Club was formed in 1975 and has continually developed the rodeo and camp draft complex over the years. Situated on crown land in Showground complex improvements include shower and toilet block and other amenities that have enhanced the rodeo and camp drafting experience for competitors and spectators.

The new fencing will make the arena more accessible and user friendly for all users of the grounds and safer for the animals, spectators and competitors. In the past black hessian was attached to the post and wire fencing.
