

# VISIT BRADMAN'S BIRTHPLACE MUSEUM

## 89 ADAMS STREET COOTAMUNDRA



Stand in the room where Australian Cricketing legend Sir Donald Bradman AC was born on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 1908.

The small cottage, 'Irena', that was the birthplace of Australian cricketing legend, Sir Donald Bradman AC, has been lovingly restored and is now a museum housing memorabilia of his cricketing career, cricketing history and offers a rare glimpse into the life of this sporting legend. The adjoining Memorabilia Cottage houses a collection of bric-a-brac and collectables that will bring back memories of the past.

The Bradman's Birthplace Museum is listed on the registrar of the National Estate and was the home of Granny Scholz, the midwife who delivered Sir Donald Bradman on the 27<sup>th</sup> August, 1908 in the front room of the cottage. It is also part of the Bradman Trail that traces the life of the world's greatest cricketer, Sir Donald Bradman AC, through the places he lived - Cootamundra, Bowral and Adelaide.

The museum is staffed entirely by volunteers and is open 7 days a week, excluding some public holidays, from 9am till 5pm, include a visit to the Birthplace on your itinerary.

Coaches are most welcome, advance booking are essential to receive a free 'cuppa'. A minimal entry fee applies to adults, and children are free. Donations to the upkeep of the museum are gratefully accepted and are tax deductible. Please make cheques payable to Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council, Bradman Birthplace Museum.
