KERBSIDE GREEN WASTE COLLECTION - Residents of Cootamundra, Wallendbeen and Stockinbingal are advised Council will be undertaking this collection from Monday 7 May to Friday 11 May 2018. Green waste is to be placed neatly stacked, without obstruction to pedestrians, in front of your residence (not laneways) the week starting Sunday 6 May 2018 and will be collected on the same day as your normal garbage service (If your green waste has not been collected on your garbage day, please leave it kerbside as it will be collected by council staff by the end of the week). All loose waste must be secured with string or placed in cardboard boxes. Plastic bags will not be collected. Check Councils website for items that will not be eligible for collection. As the Burra Road Landfill in Gundagai has no charge for Green Waste, no kerbside pick will take place in Gundagai areas.

WORKS REPORT

Parks & Gardens staff have assisted with preparations for the Cootamundra picnic races. Repairs have been carried out to the effluent filter in Jubilee Park. Water has now been restored. Work has

continued with removing the exotic trees growing in Muttama Creek. A new child swing seat was replaced at Nicholson Park playground. Tree trimming along the main street of Stockinbingal has been completed to assist with the upgrade works. All new garden ties were placed around the standard roses in Albert Park. Town Hall Gardens have been pruned and weeded. Clean up and mowing works have taken



place at the Old Goal. Tree trimming and clearing work has taken place at Anzac Grove and the Cenotaph to ensure the areas are ready for ANZAC Day Ceremonies. Line marking of the Junior Mod Soccer fields and placement of goal posts at Mitchell Park for the Branch Titles has been completed. Irrigation repairs were carried out at Nicholson Park and Albert Park. Repairs to supply pipe work of treated effluent irrigation system in Owen Vincent Oval has taken place. Gundagai sporting fields preparation works prior to the start of rugby league competitions has been carried out. Works are continuing on the Burley Griffin Way through the Stockinbingal township. Reconstruction of the road pavement is now well underway, with new road base material expected to be placed and compacted over the next week. All drainage works have been completed allowing construction of new kerb and gutter along

the rest area adjacent to the railway station to commence. Replacement of the water main at the Dudauman Road intersection is scheduled to be undertaken in the next week. While these works are underway, traffic will be under traffic control and 40Km/hr speed limits. Work is underway on the replacement of the Shed Creek Bridge on Threeways Road. The old deck has been removed with construction of new bridge abutments underway. Once these are placed, placement of the new deck can commence. While these works are underway, Threeways Road will be closed with traffic requested to detour via Redhill/Billapaloopa Road. Work on widening culverts on the Nangus Road is also progressing with concrete aprons expecting to be poured within the next week.
