#### **WORKS REPORT**

Works are progressing on the Burley Griffin Way through the Stockinbingal township. Reconstruction of road pavement is continuing with stabilising of the sub-grade pavement now complete. Placement and compaction of the road base is progressing on the eastern end. Once the pavement is placed, fully compacted and trimmed, preparation for bitumen sealing will commence. New kerb and gutter along the rest area adjacent to the railway station is expected to be constructed in early May. While these works are underway, traffic control and 40Km/hr speed limits will be in place.

Work on the replacement of the Shed Creek Bridge on Three Ways Road has now seen the new bridge deck placed. Council crews are now working on constructing new concrete

approach slabs each side of the new bridge deck. Once these are complete, work will commence on the replacement of the road approaches. While these works are underway, Threeways Road will be closed with traffic requested to detour via Redhill/Billapaloopa Road. Work on widening culverts on the Nangus Road is also progressing well with the box culverts now in place. Other heavy patching works on Nangus Road are expected to be undertaken over the

next couple of weeks to repair identified failed sections of pavement. Maintenance grading is still underway on gravel roads in the Wee Jasper area and will progress around to the Adjungbilly area. General road maintenance including patching is being undertaken on roads around the shire area. Parks and Garden Staff have been busy removing trees in the Gundagai area with works

continuing on removing exotic trees from Muttama Creek. Annuals have been planted in Cootamundra CBD in the main street and roundabout gardens. Albert Park and surrounds were prepared for Anzac Day commemorations. Repairs have been carried out to the irrigation system at the Gallipoli Rose Gardens and Jubilee Park. New ties placed around standard roses in Gallipoli Rose Garden. General park maintenance including mowing, weeding and garbage collection from several park events has been

completed plus seat replacements in Fisher Park grandstand.

Council resolved at the Council Meeting held on 24 April 2018 to hold the Ordinary Meeting of Council, scheduled for the 29 May 2018 on the 22 May 2018 to facilitate the advertising requirement for the Operational and Delivery Plan.

Council resolved to conduct a workshop on the prioritisation of the applications which have been received for the Stronger Country Communities Fund Round 2 (SCCF2) on Monday 30 April 2018. Successful projects approved for submission will be advertised.
