PARKING RESTRICTIONS SHERIDAN ST At the last Ordinary Council Meeting recommendations of the CGRC Traffic Committee concerning Sheridan Street Parking were adopted. The recommendation reintroduces the 2 hour parking restrictions in Sheridan Street Gundagai. The restrictions include signage for disabled parking, No Stopping and bus zone areas. <u>DOUBLE LINES IN SHERIDAN STREET</u>: RMS and CGRC Traffic committee deem it unsafe for motorists to negotiate a U Turn into a parking space on the opposite side of the street due to the width of the carriageway. Motorists can make a 90 degree turn into laneways or vehicle entrances on opposite side of the street.

#### OFF LEASH AREA IN GUNDAGAI

Council is calling for public comment on locations for off-leash dog areas in Gundagai. Currently there are no off-leash dog parks in the old Gundagai Shire area. Councils are required to provide off-lease areas to comply with the Companion Animals legislation. CGRC officers have identified some suitable locations within

Gundagai. The area known as Sherwood Forest including Heydon Park and also Friendship Park in North Gundagai. Other options proposed are the riverbank area on the western side of the scout hall and Lindley Park in South Gundagai. Heydon Park which from time to time is used by sporting groups, would only be used as an off-leash area when organised sport is not utilising the park. Dog parks & off-leash areas can provide dogs with a secure environment to exercise and socialise with other dogs. Dogs benefit greatly from the chance to run freely and is also a great form of exercise for dog owners. Dog waste bins and bags will be provided in all off-leash areas, with signage erected to advise dog owners on etiquette and hours of use. #### OPERATIONS REPORT



Parks & Recreation staff completed daily CBD Street sweeping, litter removal, mowing, whipper snipping, edging, hand weeding, cleaning barbeques, tree maintenance and actioning on customer requests. The Soccer goal posts at Mitchell Park have been taken down in preparation for the upcoming cricket season. The rugby league posts at Nicholson Park have been removed in preparation for the touch football season. The synthetic cricket wickets have had their wicket creases painted and repaired as the cricket season is about to commence. Staff painted the outer boundary lines in Albert Park, Clarke Oval, Stockinbingal and Wallendbeen Recreation Grounds. The Fisher Park Grandstand was pressure washed and one seat repaired. The Cootamundra Sports fields have been sprayed for broadleaf weeds. Staff have commenced work on playground audits throughout Cootamundra and Gundagai. Staff have been busy with maintenance and events. New banners have been erected in the Cootamundra CBD light

poles promoting the Cootamundra Show. Event bins were delivered to the Cootamundra Turf Club for the races. These bins were then collected, washed and stored away. Staff have planted the Cootamundra CBD, along with fixing irrigation and fertilising garden beds. Additional works involved whipper snipping and spraying weeds in footpaths, concrete traffic islands and roundabouts. Staff have removed another swarm of bees from a Street tree in Cootamundra. Recreation staff have completed 10 days of Intensive Learn to Swim Schools Program for Local Schools. Three schools participated in the program, with another three schools booked for December. Preparations are underway for the upcoming summer swim season, with recreation staff performing routine maintenance to the pool prior to being filled, as well as works to the grounds. Works crews have been street sweeping and patching potholes around the area. Maintenance grading has been carried out in Old Treatment Works Lane and Turners Lane. Crews will continue with maintenance grading in Wallendbeen, and improvements to town drainage.
