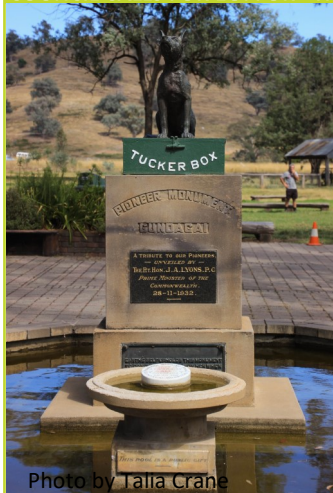


## COUNCIL CALLS FOR EOI FOR 'THE DOG ON THE TUCKERBOX'

## OPERATIONS REPORT

Maintenance grading will continue over the coming weeks on roads in the Muttama area with Finlay's and Wambidgee Roads recently completed. In the Cootamundra area roads have been graded including Cullinga Road, West Jindalee, Warralong Road and Salt Clay Lane. Heavy patching works are set to commence on the Olympic Highway to the south of Cootamundra near Frampton Road and will then progress onto various sections on the Burley Griffin Way between Wallendbeen and Stockinbingal. While these works are underway, motorists are asked to abide by the direction of traffic controllers and speed limits. Possible short delays can be expected.



The last section of the rehabilitation works on the Old Hume Highway has now been sealed. The next work for this crew is a section of stabilisation on the Adelong Road in the Tumblong townships. Earthworks are underway on the Adjungbilly Road realignment. Initial works will see tree removal along the new alignment and then works to cut and remove material to form up the new road pavement. Bitumen road maintenance including roadside weed spraying has continued around the Council area. Footpath replacement works are continuing in Cootamundra with work on the Cooper Street footpath adjacent to the Public School. Work is underway on the footpath in Virgil Street Gundagai.



Construction works are progressing on the Cootamundra Truck wash upgrade. All the concrete holding tanks and extension of the wash down bay are now complete. Preliminary earthworks have commenced to enable the roadway approach to the wash bay to be sealed. While this work is underway the truckwash will be out of operation. The Cootamundra water main replacement project is progressing with replacement of the main along Hurley Street. Works are now complete on the Yass Road shoulder widenings to cater for vehicle turning movements at the new fuel depot. Last week saw the last of the new asphalt surface being laid and the roadway being line marked to cater for changes in traffic flow past the depot.

Council's resealing contractor Boral is undertaking resealing on various roads in the Gundagai area. Recently resealed roads include sections of Nangus, Bethungra and Oura Roads. Interflow are still working on the sewer mains lining project in the Cootamundra township. Parks & Recreation staff line marked Albert Park was for the Sacred Heart athletics carnival along with preparation for the commencement of little athletics. Council tidied the site around the new cricket wicket at Clarke Oval with staff placing clean top soil in and around the wicket and laid new turf. Pansies have been removed from the CBD garden beds and replaced with Petunias for the summer. Staff have continued to work on tree requests around Cootamundra. Cenotaphs areas were mowed, pruned, cleaned and tidied for Remembrance Day. Event



bins were delivered to the Cootamundra Public School for the school fete. Bins were then collected, washed and stored away. Two doors had been vandalised at Coota West Railway Park building. Both entrance doors have been replaced to make the area secure. The flag pole at the airport has been repaired and painted. The sink in the heritage room of Ellwood Hall Stockinbingal has been removed and one of the side doors has been repaired. Cootamundra pool staff held a successful Water Safety Day. The day hosted over 200 children from local schools. The Cootamundra Outdoor Pool opened for the summer season on Saturday, 17 November.
