OPERATIONS REPORT Earthworks are continuing on Adjungbilly Road realignment project. Crews are clearing fallen branches and debris from recent storms. Preparation for Coota Beach Volleyball Carnival being held 16/17 February will commence 11 February. Murray Street will be closed between Wallendoon and Bourke Streets from Wednesday 12 until Monday 17 February 2109. The new concrete kerb in Cooper Street adjacent to the public school will be complete by the first week in February. The road shoulder has been excavated with new pavement material placed and compacted. Sealing will be undertaken in the next couple of weeks. The



placement of asphalt at the Cootamundra truck wash will be completed early February with final road works commencing in February. New concrete plinths are being constructed at Gundagai and Cootamundra cemeteries. Drainage works are progressing in Homer Street to address water flow from the Church area onto the street. Road shoulder grading has been completed on sections of Old Gundagai and Rosehill Roads in preparation for bitumen resealing. Maintenance patching along shire roads and roadside slashing/weed spraying is being carried out as required and as conditions permit. Patching works on Brungle Road have been completed and will be sealed in the coming week. Road



Patching Works on Brungle Road nave been completed and Will be sealed in the coming Week. Road maintenance along Reef Creek and Jerusalem Road is also planned for the coming week. Rehabilitation works are underway on sections of Hopewood Road. Council's resealing contractor Boral is continuing with resealing various roads and streets around the Council area. Resealing works on sections of the Olympic Highway and Burley Griffin Way will commence on 6 February. While these works are underway, motorist can expect short delays. Parks & Gardens staff have been weeding, mulching and watering. Jubilee Park was prepared for the Australia Day ceremony. Council event bins were picked up from Nicholson Park following the annual touch football carnival, while further bins were delivered to Jubilee Park prior to the Australia Day celebrations. A new goal post has been installed at Clarke Oval prior to commencement of the upcoming AFL season, along with repairs to the irrigation. Trimming of

overhanging trees continues around Cootamundra laneways to provide better access for residents and the garbage truck. Staff cleared a number of fallen trees and branches around Cootamundra due to several storms bringing down debris. Nangus playground was maintained in readiness for the opening of the new playground. Staff cleared up fallen trees and limbs in the area. The Dog on the Tuckerbox pond has received a new coat of paint. The surrounding area was mowed. The Gundagai main street was cleaned using the new pavement scrubber.
