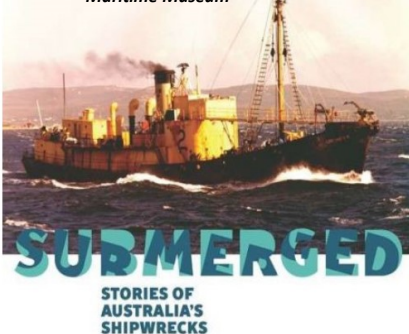

Adjungbilly Road Upgrade -

The Gobaralong Adjungbilly Road Upgrade at Adjungbilly Hill will allow better access for B-Doubles and long vehicles. The section has been considered by council and residents to be dangerous and difficult for long vehicles including school buses to negotiate safely. The project is progressing well and is expected to be delivered ahead of schedule.



OPERATIONS REPORT

The Adjungbilly Road realignment project is progressing along with earthworks on the well underway. To enable the works to proceed, full road closures will be in place at 30 minute intervals for the next few weeks. Culvert extensions and associated drainage will also be underway from mid-February. Works crew have been busy cleaning up from the recent heavy rainfall in the Cullinga/Rosehill areas and wind damage in the Stockinbingal area. Cootamundra crews have assisted with preparation and clean-up for the recent Beach Volleyball competition. The new concrete kerb is now complete in Cooper Street adjacent to the public school. Sealing of the road shoulder will take place in the next couple of weeks. The final roadworks at the Cootamundra Truck wash are now complete. Again sealing of this work will take place within the next couple of weeks. New speed limit signage has been erected on Pinkerton Road and Gundagai Road. These new limits were approved by the RMS and involve the replacement of the 70 km/hr limits with 50 km/hr limits in order to standardise traffic speeds on the approaches to town. Drainage works are nearing completion in Homer Street to address water flow from the Church area onto the street. Work on replacing the Morley's Creek footbridge is scheduled to commence mid-February. Road shoulder grading is currently underway on Dirnaseer Road, Berthong Road with a crew heading to Burra Road in the next week. Maintenance grading has been undertaken on Hopewood Road and Sheep Station Creek Road. Grading on Wee Jasper Road will commence prior to the end of February. Maintenance patching along shire roads and roadside slashing/weed spraying is being carried out as required and as conditions permit. Council's resealing contractor Boral has just finished the sealing works on the Olympic Highway and Burley Griffin Way. Resealing will now continue onto various roads and streets around the council area. While these works are underway, motorist can expect short delays. Council



parks crew cleared a number of fallen trees and branches around Cootamundra and Stockinbingal due to several storms. Staff provided traffic control due to the dangerous flood water over several roads. Preparation has commenced for the upcoming beach volleyball tournament. This includes painting the spectator grandstands, weeding courts, installing umpire stands, trimming trees along with other general set up duties. Irrigation repairs were carried out at Stockinbingal Rec Ground. The athletics track was line marked at Albert Park. The Oval was also sprayed with a turf growth regulator that will inhibit vertical growth whilst improving the turf thickness, uniformity and health. The grass growing on to the synthetic cricket wickets on various grounds in Cootamundra were whipper snipped and cleaned. Event bins were picked up from Jubilee Park, while extra event bins were delivered to Cootamundra racecourse. The men's toilet door at the Wallendoon Street toilet block had to be repaired after the door had been kicked off the wall. Building maintenance repairs were carried out at the airport terminal building. Noxious Weed Spraying notification is done in accordance with the Pesticide Regulation 1995. Herbicide application will occur during the months of February and March 2019 in the town streets and lanes, village streets and lanes for the eradication of weeds in the road and culverts, as well as weed control in various other public spaces across the Council area.
