EASTER AND ANZAC DAY GARBAGE CHANGES - Residents are advised the garbage collections for Friday 20 April, Monday 22 April and Thursday 25 April 2019 will remain unchanged. NOTE: Normal collection times may vary. Please ensure that your bin/ s are put out the night before as the service will start earlier than normal to enable two collections on the one day.



Residents of Cootamundra, Wallendbeen and Stockinbingal are advised Council will be undertaking the green waste kerbside collection from 6 May to 10 May 2019. Green waste is to be placed neatly stacked, without obstruction to pedestrians, in front of your residence (not laneways) the week starting Sunday 5 May 2019 and will be collected on the same day as your normal garbage service for this week only. (If your green waste has not been collected on your garbage day, please leave it kerbside as it will be collected by council staff by the end of the week). All loose waste must be secured with string or placed in cardboard boxes. Plastic bags are not to be utilised and will not be collected. OPERATIONS REPORT

Gravel road resheeting has been completed throughout Stockinbingal township. This crew is now working on maintenance grading and will move to the Yannawah area in the coming weeks. Repairs to drainage structures on Old Cootamundra Road continue. Maintenance of town



signage and delineation is continuing around townships and villages as required. Maintenance patching along Council roads and weed spraying is being carried out as required and as conditions permit. Line marking has commenced on the recently resealed areas around the Council area. Line marking has been completed on various sporting fields. Country Club Oval was line marked for rugby union. Wallendbeen Recreation Ground for the annual small athletic

Oval was line marked for rugby union, Wallendbeen Recreation Ground for the annual small athletic and ball games schools' event "The Baldry Shield" and Albert Park athletics track . Senior goal posts were erected at Nicholson Park and both Nicholson Park and Fisher Park were line marked. The

grandstand was pressure washed for the Group 9 junior rugby league trials. The cricket wicket at Clarke Oval has been covered in preparation for the upcoming AFL season. New Soccer posts have been installed in Gundagai and the gardens at the Goal maintained. Annual flowers have been taken out and the soil for garden has been rejuvenated, ready for planting Pansies in the coming weeks. Staff have continued to trim the Cootamundra laneways so the garbage truck has better access for collecting bins. The newly planted street trees were watered and fertilised in Cootamundra, Stockinbingal and



Wallendbeen. Staff repaired toilet doors, locks and hand towel dispensers in Fisher Park tunnel. Several park seats have been repaired and painted as part of our maintenance schedule. The fishpond feature at the town library has been re-sealed to remove any potential leaks. The old Cootamundra hospital was treated for rats and mice. Irrigation repairs were carried out at Nicholson Park. Staff delivered 30 event bins to the Cootamundra Turf Club for the annual picnic races. Event bins were also delivered to the airport for the muscle car sprint trials.
