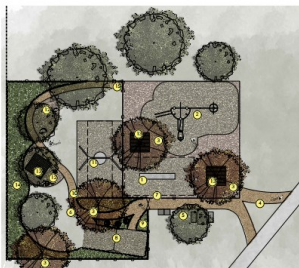

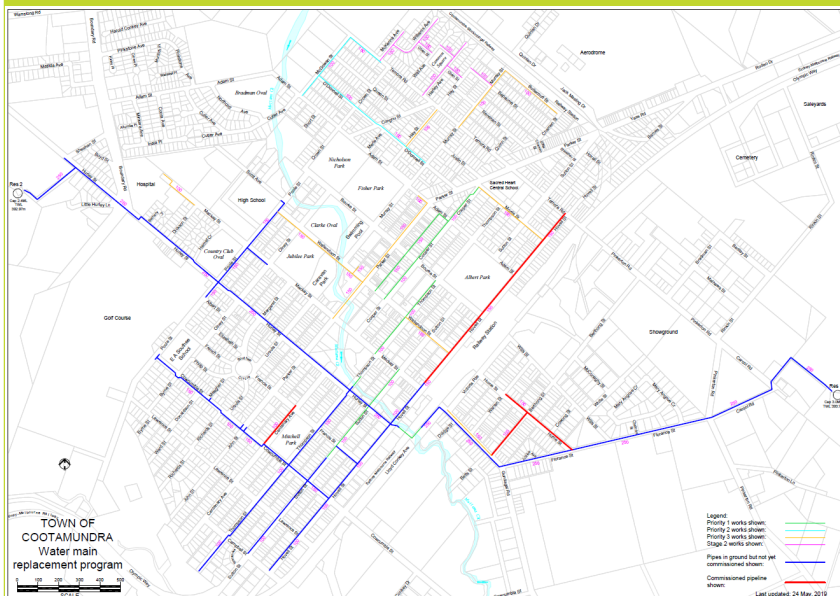

COOTAMUNDRA GOLF COURSE PROJECT UPDATE - Contractors, Darling Irrigation of Wagga Wagga have commenced work on the installation of a new irrigation system for the golf course and bowling greens at the Cootamundra Country Club. Funding for this and, other projects at the Club, was received from the State Government under the Stronger Communities Fund (R2). The project involves the trenching for, and laying of, well in excess of 10km of pipelines with diameters from 63mm to 250mm. The system will be fully automated and designed to irrigate at night when losses through evaporation are minimised. Contract completion anticipated to be early September.

DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF WATER PLAYGROUND AT COOTAMUNDRA SWIMMING POOL - Council is seeking tenders from suitably qualified and experienced Contractors for the design and construction of a water playground to be located at the Cootamundra Swimming Pool. WATER AND SEWER ACCOUNTS—Council has recently processed Water & Sewer billing for the final quarter of the 2018-2019 year, for the period ended 31 May 2019, and the Water & Sewer accounts will be received by ratepayers shortly. The due date for payment is Friday 21 June, 2019, with the various options for payment outlined on the Water & Sewer notices. Should you be experiencing difficulty in paying the account by the due date, please contact Council as soon as possible to discuss payment arrangements.

OPERATIONS REPORT

Work is progressing on Adjungbilly Road with earthworks and pavement construction continuing on the lower end. Work on the rehabilitation of the section of Muttama Road near Wambidgee Road is also progressing. Current works include replacing and widening culverts and road shoulder preparation. This work is being funded by the RMS from the REPAIR program. The Cootamundra Crews have completed earthworks and pavement construction of a cul-d-sac at the end of West Street in Stockinbingal. This work was funded by the RMS and was one of the final projects of the recent rehabilitation project of Hibernia Street in Stockinbingal. Maintenance grading has been carried out on Rawilla and Wave Hill Roads. The crew is currently working on Yamatree Road and will continue in this area over the next week. Contractors have now completed culvert repairs on Dirnaseer, Old Wallendbeen and Old Cootamundra Roads which were works funded from the 2016 Storm disaster funding. Other flood restoration work has included Caulderwood Road where gravel resheeting has been undertaken. Replacement of the kerb in Justin Street has seen preliminary works commence with service locations and tree trimming. Excavation of the old kerb should be underway by 3 June. Work is currently underway on the stormwater drainage for the Sheridan/West Street intersection upgrade. Building work is underway on the new toilet block in Sheridan Street, Gundagai. General patching and roadside spraying has been completed as required.

WEEDS MANAGEMENT



Council is required under the Biosecurity Act 2105 to control and eradicate weeds on Council owned land (roadside included), privately owned land including

landowners and lessees and Crown land on behalf of the State Government. CGRC Weed Spraying Officers will be conducting Weed Spraying across the region from June to December 2019. This spraying program will be in Cootamundra, Gundagai and all villages and will encompass streets, laneways, road sides, culverts and various other public spaces across the region.
