Work on the Justin Street kerb replacement has seen the kerb replaced along the southern side and removal of the old kerb along the northern side. Work is currently underway on preparing the kerb foundation along the northern side with the new kerb expected to be poured by the end of the first week in July. Final tidy up of the kerb returns into Parker and Murray Streets will follow. Pavement repairs and resealing along the kerb will take place once the road base has consolidated. Work on the Turners Lane

causeway is progressing with the box culverts and upper concrete deck now in place. The next stage will be to reconstruct the roadway approaches either side of the causeway. This project is being funded from the Roads To Recovery Program. Preliminary work is underway on Old Gundagai Road with the removal of vegetation completed. Due to the realignment of the roadway around the curves by approximately 1.5 meters to the west, some of the existing vegetation required removal. Council will undertake revegetation with new trees to be planted along the new road batters to offset the removal of this vegetation. Pipe and culvert extensions are underway on this project. This project is also being funded from the Roads To Recovery Program. Maintenance grading and gravel resheeting is continuing on Brawlin Road. Shoulder grading is also continuing along Old Cootamundra Road. Council will be holding a meeting with all registered sporting and recreation groups interested in working with Council on matters relating to sporting fields and recreation facilities. One member from each club or group is invited to attend. The initial meeting is to be held at the Alby Schultz Centre, Cooper Street on Thursday, 4 July 2019 at 6:00 pm. If your club or group wishes to participate please contact Council on 1300 459 689. Council are in the process of reviewing current policy documents and associated procedures regarding the operation of the Cootamundra Waste Depot located in Turners Lane. As a part of this review and until the Waste Strategy has been completed and adopted, it has been determined that access outside of normal operating hours be restricted to Council and

contracted employees only. Residents are advised due to I increased reports of vandalism and antisocial behaviour, security cameras will be installed at the Fisher Park Grandstand and the Cootamundra Skate Park. These cameras are motion activated and footage is stored remotely which and will be accessed when required.



COUNCIL / COMMUNITY BUS - Council resolved to trial usage of the Council bus by Community Groups. Community Group members who wish to utilise the bus must be inducted by Council prior to being permitted to drive the bus.
