### **MAJOR WORKS ON GUNDAGAI SWIMMING POOL COMMENCE**

Council has commenced the installation of a disabled ramp and resurfacing at the Gundagai Swimming Pool. Excavation of the site has commenced and will see a 25 metre long zero depth entry ramp installed on the eastern edge of the Olympic pool. The ramp will enable easy access to the pool. The



project is a result of a grant from the Stronger Communities Fund Round 1. An initiative of the NSW State Government and administered by CGRC, this project will cost \$300,000. \$146,000 will be spent on the ramp, with the remainder of the funding to be spent on the resurfacing and other minor works. The Project should be completed by mid-October.

### **WORKS REPORT**

Justin Street kerb and gutter replacement works are now complete. The remaining repairs to the road surface will be completed in the next few weeks after the road base has settled and



consolidated. Work is underway on the replacement of the old footpath along Temora Street between Parker and Murray Streets. This work was prioritised due to the poor state of the existing path which had deteriorated over time mainly due to tree roots lifting and cracking the concrete. Gravel resheeting and road maintenance has been underway along Brawlin and Back Brawlin Roads. Several additional kilometres of shoulder grading has been completed along Old Cootamundra Road. The construction of the new causeway in Turners Lane is now complete. Final works will see the approaches to the causeway sealed to prevent erosion should the causeway overtop. Work on the Old Gundagai Road reconstruction project has now seen the culverts extended with preliminary works underway on the trimming and reshaping of the batters. Council Parks & Gardens staff have been busy with refurbishments of existing Cootamundra CBD street furniture and associated infrastructure. This work

commenced back in May 2019 as a result of a condition audit undertaken of Cootamundra's main CBD area. This identified Cootamundra's CBD areas had good quality civil infrastructure i.e. roads, kerb & gutter, stormwater, lighting, etc., however the visual amenity of the street furniture and associated infrastructure was in a poor condition. Council resolved to commence a clean-up of all existing infrastructure and replace missing, damaged or dead items including trees, shrubs, bins, signs etc. The garden refurbishments have included removing inappropriate plants, recondition and fertilising the soil, repairing irrigation and replanting including feature annual display gardens. Work will continue with repairing, refurbishing and painting of all furniture and civil infrastructure using a more historic selection of colours, while revitalising the look of the CBD area. All this work




is carried out and funded as part of Council's normal maintenance budget. Credit to all Council staff who have participated in the design and selection of colours, plant selection and have accepted the challenge with enthusiasm and professionalism. Management and Council is proud of the high quality of workmanship, pride and initiative shown by Council's Parks & Gardens staff. This work is just the start of a very large project to fully revitalise Councils parks & gardens, street trees and street scapes. All work as described above will include the surrounding villages. Council thanks all the community and businesses who have supported staff in helping with the implementation of the works program.
