TO THE COOTAMUNDRA HOUSEHOLDER—NOTICE REGARDING YOUR BIN—

Council has adopted a warning system to ensure garbage bins are being used correctly. Warnings will be issued for the following infringements:-

RECYCLING WAS BAGGED—Only acceptable recyclables to be placed loosely in the yellow lidded bin, NO bagging items.

OBSTRUCTION—Your bins were obstructed by vehicles, trees or were placed too close together to allow for collection

OVERWEIGHT/OVERFULL—If the arm of the truck is unable to lift your bin in can not be collected.

GARBAGE HAS NOT BEEN SORTED CORRECTLY—The truck camera has detected unclean waste in your recycling bin, or general waste in your green waste, or an unacceptable item in your bin.

WARNINGS WILL BE PLACED ON YOUR BIN INDICATING THE BELOW:

Black = 1ST WARNING

Yellow = 2ND WARNING

Orange = FINAL WARNING

Red = NO LONGER SERVICED
