NEW IRRIGATION FOR COOTAMUNDRA COUNTRY CLUB

A large crowd gathered at Cootamundra Country Club, to mark the opening of the new irrigation system on the Golf Course. The project is the result of a \$1.35 million grant from the NSW State Government. The Stronger Country Communities Fund Round Two program is a NSW State Government initiative and has been administered by Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council (CGRC). The Project will ensure and enhance the future long-term sustainability of the Cootamundra Country Club

facilities. Founded in 1895 the course is the oldest 18-hole country course in New South Wales. The Club uses Cootamundra - Gundagai Regional Council treated sewerage water for irrigation. A new maintenance shed is nearing completion and work is soon to commence on new cart paths as part of the overall grant.



NEW COMMUNITY GARDEN TAKING SHAPE IN GUNDAGAI
The Gundagai Community Garden Project has seen raised planting beds and new water tanks installed. The project is the result of a Stronger Country Communities Round Two Grant, an initiative of the NSW State Government and administered by Council (CGRC). The community garden is aimed at creating a greater sense of

community within Gundagai. The works are being carried out on the corner of Otway Street and First Avenue. The garden will include a garden shed, 30 garden beds, and irrigation. Secure fencing, picnic bench, a barbeque, a hedge of natives and rain water tanks will be installed all for the use of the community and allow them to enjoy locally grown, fresh produce.

OPERATIONS REPORT

Shoulder grading and table drain maintenance has been completed on Dudauman Road and a section of Muttama Road between Jugiong Road and Brawlin Road. Work is nearing completion on the extensions to the taxiway at the Cootamundra Aerodrome. Drainage culverts have been installed with the pavement now to be prepared for sealing. This work is being done to assist with the refilling of water tankers by the RFS when required for firefighting purposes. Council's resealing contractor Boral is continuing with resealing on prioritised roads. Patching around the bitumen road network is being undertaken as required. Road side spraying and slashing will continue as required around the council area. Preliminary works are proceeding with the RMS in readiness for upgrading of the Olympic Highway from Back Brawlin Road and Dirnaseer Road. The first part of this work will involve culvert replacement and some tree removal.
