Free suppa & a cuppa provided. The Minister for Local Government, the Hon. Shelley Hancock (the Minister), received a proposal to effectively re-establish the former Gundagai Shire Council and Cootamundra Shire Council local government areas. This proposal has now been formally referred to the Local Government Boundaries Commission, as an independent statutory authority, for examination and report. To clarify this process Council has engaged Dr Joseph Drew, an Associate Professor of Public Policy and Local Government from the University of Technology Sydney. Dr Drew is developing a series of videos to ensure the community are fully informed of Councils position in regard to the merger, address public misconceptions about the merger, and explain concepts of the Boundaries Commission inquiry. CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS ON OLYMPIC HIGHWAY NEAR COOTAMUNDRA—The Olympic Highway at The Gap, three kilometres south of Cootamundra will be closed on Tuesday 25th February between 7am and 6pm while drainage is upgraded as part of a project to improve safety. Vehicles will be detoured via the Hi-Vehicle Bypass using Dirnaseer Road, Suttons Lane, Old Cootamundra Road and Stockinbingal Road, adding up to 10 minutes travel time. Outside of this closure, work will continue between 7am and 6pm weekdays under single lane road closures and reduced speed limits. The safety upgrade, which includes rebuilding the road surface, improving drainage and safety barriers, is expected to be completed by Thursday 30 April 2020, weather permitting. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, and follow the directions of signs and traffic control. Transport for NSW thanks motorists for their patience during this time. Council advises residents across the region that weed spraying will be undertaken. Notification is done in accordance with the Pesticide Regulation 1995. CIVIL WORKS AND TECHINICAL SERVICES NEWS

Maintenance grading has commenced on Brawlin Road to repair washouts and surface damage following the January storm in that area. Other grading works are currently in progress at Bundarbo and will continue on Cooininee and Coggans Roads. Works on Muttama Road adjacent to the intersection with Wambidgee Road have now commenced. Work includes drainage, general earthworks and pavement rehabilitation in preparation for an overlay. This project is expected to run into March, 2020 and is funded from the Regional Road REPAIR program. Works on Cootamundra Netball Courts have seen the pavement constructed. Placement of the asphalt surface is scheduled for late February. Gundagai crews have been undertaking storm damage repairs on various roads including Hoares Lane, Darbalara, Cooininee, Tarrabandra and Tumblong Roads. The stormwater drainage works in Tor Street, Eagle Street, Luke Street and Nicholls Avenue, Gundagai are now complete. During the recent rain, these projects successfully redirected the rainfall away from properties as anticipated. Future works are planned in West and South Streets. Patching, slashing and other general maintenance has been undertaken as required around the entire Local Government Area. Works are continuing on the Gap Bridge project in Cootamundra. New lighting and a new pitch have passed the test at Fisher park with a Day/Night Cricket match held recently deemed a success. The new lights are turned on and off by each user group, using a phone app. The new lights are a great asset to Fisher Park for winter and summer sports. The lights replace the old ones, which have been a part of the Fisher Park infrastructure since the mid to late 1970's. Parks and Gardens staff continue to develop and enhance our main street gardens.
