**NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC - MAIN STREET UPGRADE – (Continuation -Block 3) - SHERIDAN STREET (Homer Street Easterly towards Virgil Street)** - Notice is hereby given that Council has scheduled reconstruction work commencing at the intersection of Sheridan & Homer Street extending in an easterly direction towards Virgil Street. Plans of the first stage of the Upgrade will extend towards the Gundagai Medical Centre. Works will include footpath reconstruction, Kerb and Gutter replacement, street drainage and road pavement rehabilitation. (Approximately 70% of the Street pavement). This program will continue the previously completed Main Street Upgrading work (Otway to Homer Street.). Plans of the intended work will be on public display at the Gundagai Council Offices (255 Sheridan Street Gundagai). Reconstruction work has been scheduled to commence in during July 2021. **COOTAMUNDRA SALEYARDS** - Due to current COVID restrictions and after receiving advise from the Dept. of Local Government a decision has been made to revert to COVID restrictions Phase 2 at the Cootamundra Saleyards. It is hoped that these restrictions will only be for a short time but will apply for the next sheep sale which is to be held on Wednesday 7 July 2021. The following restrictions will apply from 5 July 2021. The only people that will be allowed to attend the sale are.

1. Essential saleyards staff
2. Essential agency staff and accredited agents
3. Genuine buyers with a true intent to purchase.
4. Livestock transporters with access to loading/unloading ramps.
5. MLA livestock market officers.

A further condition will be if attendees are unable to maintain a 4sq mtr rule they are to wear face masks and general hygiene and safe distancing rules will apply.

**WORK ON ROSEHILL ROAD:** CGRC is currently undertaking road works on Rosehill Road to replace the old narrow bridge at "The Willows" at Cullinga Creek which is approximately 1 km along from Old Gundagai Road intersection. Traffic will be detoured to a side-track around the site. This will allow new box culverts to be installed. The side-track may not be suitable for wide machinery. The work is expected to take four weeks if conditions are favourable. CGRC apologises for any inconvenience caused during these vital works.
