**PUBLIC WORKS** - Bridge and culvert maintenance works to commence this week with scour repairs on Brungle Road the first priority. Culvert replacement is continuing on Nanangroe and Redhill Roads. Gravel resheeting is in progress in the Tumblong area. Crews will be working around the Muttama area including Finlays Lane. Maintenance grading is continuing with works completed including Rosedale and Parsons Creek Roads. The concrete sleeper retaining wall at Anzac Park has been completed, concrete staff are working on stairs at the Water Treatment Plant. Kerb and gutter replacement are complete in Merle Avenue and O'Donnell Street. The pavement reconstruction on Old Gundagai Road has now been sealed and will be line marked as soon as possible. This is a Roads to Recovery Project. General maintenance including patching and sign replacement is being undertaken around the whole LGA area. Private works are continuing at the Boundary Road Sub-division. Gravel road maintenance and resheeting has been completed in the Yannawah area and is continuing in the Jindalee and Rawilla areas. Vegetation control and drain cleaning has been undertaken on various bitumen shire roads.
