WORK ON ROSEHILL ROAD: CGRC is currently undertaking road works on Rosehill Road to replace the old narrow bridge at "The Willows" at Cullinga Creek which is approximately 1 km along from Old Gundagai Road intersection. Traffic will be detoured to a side-track around the site. This will allow new box culverts to be installed. The side-track may not be suitable for wide machinery. The work is expected to take four weeks if conditions are favourable. CGRC apologises for any inconvenience caused during these vital works.
