



POSITIONS VACANT (Re-advertised): Council currently has 3 positions vacant: **DESIGN ENGINEER, GUNDAGAI (Full time).** This role is a professional civil engineering position within Council and requires the applicant to be proficient in survey design and estimating works for roads, footpaths, culverts, bridges, stormwater drainage, water and sewerage facilities and other capital or maintenance works projects, including public recreational facilities, to ensure completion to engineering standards. **REGULATORY ATTENDANT, COOTAMUNDRA & GUNDAGAI LOCATIONS (Full time).** The function of this role includes assisting with management of weed issues as per the Biosecurity Act 2017 within the Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council Local Government Area, noxious weed control programmes, and assist in reporting weed data to NSW DPI.
