> LANDFILL/RECYCLING CENTRES: The Environment Protection Authority (EPA) is working with the waste sector and councils to minimise the impacts of COVID-19 on the industry and ensure continuity of service for the community. While councils should maintain the provision of waste services to the community no member of the public should be visiting a recycling or waste management facility as it is not one of the essential reasons for leaving your home. For people living in regional NSW who don't have a council waste collection and take their own household waste to landfill, they must store this waste safely at home in a durable bag/container and not visit the waste depot until the restrictions are lifted. The EPA also advises that waste transfer stations should stay open if they support regular domestic waste collection services managed by council or other critical waste services. CGRC waste transfer stations/landfill sites and recycling centres will be closed to the general public whilst still supporting regular domestic waste collection services managed by Council and other critical waste services only.
