



## **POSITIONS VACANT: REGULATORY ATTENDANT PERMANENT**

**FULL TIME:** Applications are invited for the Permanent Full-time position of **Regulatory Attendant** to cover both Cootamundra and Gundagai areas. The function of this role includes assisting with management of weed issues as per the Biosecurity Act 2017 within the Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council Local Government Area, noxious weed control programmes, and assist in reporting weed data to NSW DPI. As well as assisting Regulatory Services staff when required. **Key responsibilities include:** Ensures Council's compliance with the Bio-security Act 2015, by assisting with effective and compliant management strategies. Assist Biosecurity Officer to ensure private landholders within the LGA are made aware of their obligations to control or remove noxious weeds. Ensure the safety and health of employees, contractors, customers and public during the application of weed control chemicals. Ensure information regarding noxious weeds and weed classification is provided to landholders, nurseries and other relevant parties through public education programmes when required. Assist with drumMUSTER programme delivery. **GUNDAGAI SURVEY 2021 – HAVE YOUR SAY:** Council is calling for public feedback into the Gundagai Town Strategy. Council is in the process of drafting the town strategy and is seeking input from community members as part of the development of the strategy. The aim of "Gundagai Survey 2021" is to provide an opportunity for the community to assist in identifying planning opportunities and planning requirements for Gundagai. Submissions from the survey will support the production of the Gundagai Town Strategy. The finalised Gundagai Town Strategy will identify planning control objectives to help strengthen and provide opportunities to grow the Gundagai Township. This document will then provide direction for development of the proposed Cootamundra-Gundagai Local Environmental Plan. Survey's must be completed and submitted to Council by **9:00am Monday 6 September 2021.**

**BURRA ROAD ACCESS:** Work has been completed on the temporary side-track where the culvert failed. Access is now provided for residents. Suitable only for light vehicles. 5t load restriction in place.

**LANDFILL/RECYCLING CENTRES:** The Environment Protection Authority (EPA) is working with the waste sector and councils to minimise the impacts of COVID-19 on the industry and ensure continuity of service for the community. While councils should maintain the provision of waste services to the **community no member of the public should be visiting a recycling or waste management facility as it is not one of the essential reasons for leaving your home.** For people living in regional NSW who don't have a council waste collection and take their own household waste to landfill, they must store this waste safely at home in a durable bag/container and not visit the waste depot until the restrictions are lifted. The EPA also advises that waste transfer stations should stay open if they support regular domestic waste collection services managed by council or other critical waste services. CGRC waste transfer stations/landfill sites and recycling centres will be closed to the general public whilst still supporting regular domestic waste collection services managed by Council and other critical waste services only.
