A vehicle becomes unregistered when the registration is not renewed by the expiry date or when the registration is cancelled or suspended. When a vehicle is unregistered, Compulsory Third Party (CTP) insurance is not valid. This means that the vehicle is also uninsured and cannot be parked on a public road.
