## NOMINATIONS FOR AUSTRALIA DAY AWARDS NOW OPEN

Do you know someone who has gone above beyond the call of duty? Someone who achieved outstanding results. A coach, a player, a team who have accomplished great success. A young person, who leads by example, is involved in the community?

Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council (CGRC) is calling for residents and community

organisations to nominate deserving people within the region for the 2022 Australia Day Awards. Nominations are now open and will be received by Council until the 19 November 2021.

Council in conjunction with the Australia Day Council, proposes to present its Annual Australia Day Awards on 26 January 2022, at two separate ceremonies: one to be held in Gundagai and one to be held in Cootamundra.

Nominations are being invited for each of the following categories: 1. Citizen of the Year. 2. Young Citizen of the Year. 3. Sportsperson of the Year / Sports Achievement Award.

All residents from the Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council area are eligible for nomination.

Nominations can be in writing (by letter, or on the form available from Council Offices and website) and received by Council no later than 1pm Friday 19 November 2021.

The Citizen of the Year Award is for all persons of any age, whilst the Young Citizen Award is for persons aged up to 25 years as at 31

December 2021. The Sportsperson/Sports Achievement Award is open to all ages. Persons who have been nominated previously but who have not won an award are eligible for nomination. The nomination form can be found on the CGRC website or completed at the Customer Service Counters in Cootamundra and Gundagai.

COOTAMUNDRA WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM: CGRC and Killard Infrastructure Pty Ltd will soon start on the next phase of the watermain replacement program in Cootamundra. This phase of the program is being undertaken along Mackay Street between the intersections of Parker and Onley Streets. One site construction work will commence on 18 October 2021 and the duration of the work is anticipated to be 8 weeks.

MACKAY STREET/INALA PLACE FOOTBRIDGE: Work will commence on replacing the footbridge between Mackay St and Inala Pl Cootamundra W/C 25 Oct 2021. The footbridge will be closed during the construction period. The upgraded footbridge will be wider with safe approaches and suitable for mobility assisted users. The construction time will be approx. 4 weeks subject to weather. The footbridge will be closed during the construction. Pedestrians detour via footbridge between Scott and Cutler Avenues or other preferable routes during construction.



COUNCIL NEWS: At the meeting held on Tuesday 26 October 2021 Council determined a fee of \$100 per competitor for hire of the Cootamundra Aerodrome by the Southern Cross Gliding Club for their annual Summer Camp program.

i. In accordance with section 610F of the Local Government Act, 1993 the fee for hire of the Cootamundra Aerodrome by the Southern Cross Gliding Club Summer Camp be placed on public exhibition for a period of twenty eight (28) as a permanent fee.

ii. Following the exhibition period further report be prepared and submitted to Council containing any submissions received at the end of the twenty eight day exhibition period.

iii. The new fee be adopted pending no submissions be received at the end of the twenty eight day exhibition period. Submissions from interested parties will be received by Council until 5pm 28 November 2021.
