**MACKAY STREET/INALA PLACE FOOTBRIDGE**

**COOTAMUNDRA:** The footbridge is being replaced and will be closed during construction. Pedestrians detour via footbridge at Scott and Cutler Avenues or other preferable routes.

**BOURKE STREET FOOTPATH WORKS**

**COOTAMUNDRA:** Work will commence on the upgrade (beside the Olympic Hotel and Braybrook’s Pharmacy Cootamundra) between Parker Street and Cooper Lane on 27 Nov 2021 for 5 days weather permitting. Whilst works are underway, street parking will be restricted. Customers are requested to park at alternative areas. This project is funded by Local Roads and Community Infrastructure program.

**TRANSFER STATION UPGRADE:**

Council will be implementing upgrades to existing transfer stations around the villages of Muttama, Coolac, Nangus and Tumblong. The upgrades will improve safety and security at these sites. With automated gates and upgraded CCTV equipment. These changes will result in improved services and an expected reduction in illegal dumping, providing a cleaner and safer facility. Existing key holders will be required to fill out an application to exchange their existing registered key for an electronic tag at Council’s administration offices. Initial tags will be free of charge to authorised key holders. New applications and replacement of lost or stolen tags will incur a fee of \$75.00. The new entry system is expected to be in place by mid-December.

**FLUSHING OF WATER MAINS COOTAMUNDRA:**

Council wishes to inform Cootamundra Residents that extensive water main flushing will be undertaken across all sectors in the Cootamundra Township. Residents may experience low water pressure, or discoloured water during this time. CGRC apologises for any inconvenience.

**2021 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS:**

Saturday 4 December 2021. CGRC election will be administered by the NSW Electoral Commission. Voting is compulsory for Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council residents. If you do not vote and you don’t have a valid reason, you will be fined \$55 by the NSW Electoral Commission. Apparent failure to vote notices are distributed within three months of an election event. Pre polling centres at CGRC Administration Offices – Entry via Cooper Street Cootamundra. **CAUTION ROAD WORKS:**

Council will be undertaking the 2021-22 heavy patching program. The work will be concentrated on the Olympic Highway and is planned to run for two-weeks, weather dependent. During works motorists will encounter short stoppages. Works will involve stabilisation, bitumen resurfacing and line marking. All works must be completed by mid-December for the Christmas Holidays.
