MACKAY STREET/INALA PLACE FOOTBRIDGE COOTAMUNDRA: The footbridge is being replaced and will be closed during construction. Pedestrians detour via footbridge at Scott and Cutler Avenues or other preferable routes.

FOOTPATH REPAIRS – PARKER STREET COOTAMUNDRA: Work will commence on Monday 13 January on repairs to footpath/pavers outside Cootamundra Chiropractic Centre. Work should take 4 to 5 days, weather permitting.

SALE OF RECYCLABLE ITEMS: At the ordinary meeting held on 30 November 2021, Council resolved to place fees for the sale of recyclable items on public exhibition for 28 days. The objective of this initiative is to reduce the volume of waste to landfill through a circular economy and will also increase the lifespan of Council landfills. The Sale of Recyclable Items Fee Structure will be on public exhibition from Wednesday 1 December to 3pm Wednesday 29 December 2021. Council welcomes feedback during the public exhibition period. Submissions will be considered by Council before the documents are adopted at the next Ordinary Meeting of Council on 25 January 2022.

Compost/Top Dressing - < 20tonne - \$30.00/tonne (Retail Value); - > 20 tonne - \$11/tonne (Wholesale Value),(to be reviewed again for the 2022/2023 financial year); Garden Growing Mix - \$15/tonne - (to be reviewed again for the 2022/2023 financial year); Garden Mulch - \$15/tonne; Clean Fill- \$20/tonne; Processed Concrete (suitable for road/driveway/drainage/stormwater construction); \$20/ton; Recycled Timber – Minimum \$1.50/Unit; - Medium \$5.00/Unit; Maximum \$10.00/Unit; Recycled Steel (proceeds within Cootamundra to Elouera Pty Ltd) - Minimum \$5.00/Unit; - Medium \$10.00/Unit; Maximum \$20.00/Unit; Recycled Goods (chairs, tables, bikes, mowers etc) , Minimum \$5.00/Unit; Medium \$15.00/Unit; - Maximum \$30.00/Unit; Bricks, Blocks, Bush Rocks etc.- Minimum \$1.00/Unit. Maximum \$10.00/Unit. High Value Items (e.g., Antique Items etc). Specific items that are considered by Council staff to be or have a high market value above that of the normal listed maximum value, may need to be negotiated by Council staff to a value that exceeds the maximum listed price. **Unit Description** A Unit is

a saleable item that is determined as: - A single section, piece and or length of an Item (e.g., length of a piece of timber, single sheet of roofing iron etc.)*A single bulk Item (e.g., box of bolts etc)*A bound and or palletted Item (e.g., pallet of bricks/blocks/stone etc)*Bulk Items/Materials - m3 and or tonnage (e.g., soil/clean fill 1x m3 = 0.625t) Item (e.g., steel etc).

TRANSFER STATION UPGRADE: Council will be implementing upgrades to existing Waste Transfer Stations around the villages of Muttama, Coolac, Nangus and Tumblong. The new electronic and surveillance systems for these Waste Transfer Stations is progressing well with works due for completion in December. Once the infrastructure installation has been completed, Council will commence the formal change over. The intention is to have a gradual transition over to the new system, taking about 3 months to complete. Council will be contacting the existing Waste Transfer Station key holders to arrange the exchange. Once this has been completed, applications for new access swipe cards will be advertised and relevant Council services provided to service the demand.
