Mr. Bryce Collins - Junior International Athletics Champion – Hurdles
Since starting at age 10 in Little Athletics, Bryce has forged his way to become an extremely successful athlete competing in the 400m Hurdles. In 2014 he competed in the World Junior Championships, making the semi-finals and placing 17th in the world. Since then, he has won 3 NSW Championships, and placing 3rd in the Australian Championships in the 400m Hurdles. He also represented Australia at the 2019 Oceania Area Championships. He is aiming to compete at the future Commonwealth and Olympic Games. Bryce combines this athletic ability with his past studies and a successful career. He studied a Bachelor of Civil Engineering at the University of New South Wales, receiving a University Blue for his service to the sport of Athletics, as well as placing on the Deans Honours List for his entire university studies. Since graduating, Bryce is working as a Civil Engineer at Arup, working on a range of city-shaping projects while continuing with his athletics career. Bryce has also acted in a range of ambassadorial roles. He has represented the NSW Government as an Australia Day Ambassador since 2018. He has also spoken at multiple schools about his passion for his sport and the importance for taking opportunities across a range of different activities. He also acted as a scholarship ambassador at UNSW, attending a range of events and speaking about the benefits of the university and the scholarships program.
