In *My Blood* (Wild Dingo Press, 2019) is her fifth book; her previous publications are *With Just One Suitcase* (Wild Dingo Press, 2015), *Paper Cranes* (2008), *The Courage to Care* (2007) and *There's always hope: just alter the dreams* (2006).

In 2009 Cheryl was named NSW Woman of the Year, and in 2014 received the Medal of the Order of Australia for service to people with disabilities, their families and carers. Her involvement with disability services arose out of caring and advocacy for her son, Jono, who was severely injured in a vehicle accident. Cheryl continues to volunteer her time to improve health care services, which she combines with her passion for writing.

Cheryl devotes much of her public speaking to advocating for the disability arena and the rights of carers.

Cheryl is married with two adult sons and is the devoted grandmother of two grandchildren.
