YASS RD COOTAMUNDRA: Work continues along Yass Road, from the Hovell Street Intersection to the Rail Overpass Bridge. Works will take place at night to avoid disruptions. Traffic movements will be under the control of traffic management. Ongoing works rescheduled according to wet weather.

MUTTAMA ROADWORKS: Motorists are advised that work is currently underway on Muttama Road. The work is underway approximately 8km from Cootamundra (near the model aero club). These works are under traffic control and a reduced speed limit during the pavement works.

FOOTPATH RENEWAL PROJECT: The project will continue with work taking place on Bourke Street Cootamundra. While these works are underway, the footpath and carpark on the Southern side of Bourke Street will be closed, in sections between the Cooper and Thompson Street intersections. Pedestrians will be required use footpaths on the northern side of Bourke Street, or any other preferred paths for the duration of works. Car parking may not be available on Bourke Street, in this area, during works.

SERVICES RELOCATION WORK IN COOPER LANE COOTAMUNDRA: Council will commence the first stage of service relocation work in Cooper Lane Cootamundra from Monday 4 July (weather permitting). The work will begin at the Bourke Street/Cooper Lane intersection and will be closed to traffic. Motorists are requested to detour via Cooper Street or another preferred route.

DAMAGE TO BRIDGE FORCES PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURE: Motorists and residents in the Parsons Creek Road area will be diverted around the Mud Wall Creek bridge using a temporary side-track, due to the bridge being damaged. A temporary detour is in place for light traffic only. **The detour is not suitable for heavy vehicles.** Council staff erected electronic signboard, notifying road users of the conditions. The Mud Wall Creek bridge is at the Nanangroe Road end of Parsons Creek Road in the Adjungbilly area.

LED STREETLIGHT PROJECT: Work to upgrade 960 streetlights to energy efficient technology will begin this week as part of a major energy efficiency project that will save hundreds of thousands in electricity bills and reduce greenhouse gas emissions for the ratepayers of Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council (CGRC). The switch to LED technology will see a 247 MWh per year reduction in power use, delivering savings of approximately \$60,000 each year in maintenance and electricity costs.
