LED STREETLIGHT PROJECT: Work to upgrade 960 streetlights to energy efficient technology will begin this week as part of a major energy efficiency project that will save hundreds of thousands in electricity bills & reduce greenhouse gas emissions for the ratepayers of Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council (CGRC). The switch to LED technology will see a 247 MWh per year reduction in power use, delivering savings of approximately \$60,000 each year in maintenance & electricity costs.
