ITEMS ON PUBLIC EXHIBITION: At the ordinary meeting held on Tuesday 23 August 2022, Council endorsed recommendations to place on public exhibition two reports for a period of 28 days: 1. The Liquid Trade Waste Policy. 2. FOOTPATH PROJECT: Work is expected to commence in the next week, on a new footpath in Sutton St, Cootamundra ([weather permitting](#)). While these works are underway, the carpark on the western side of Sutton St will be closed, in sections between the Mackay & Hurley St intersections. Pedestrians will be required use footpaths on the eastern side of Sutton St, or other preferred paths for the duration of works. Parking may not be available in this area.

RFS HAZARD REDUCTION TEAMS: Will be undertaking ground clearance works along Salt Clay Rd, Dirnaseer, Sutton's Lane over the coming weeks. Other areas will include Coolac, Muttama and Stockinbingal as time and weather permit. This work will involve hand clearing and removal of potential combustible materials and is being carried out in preparation for the next fire season.

FLOOD DAMAGE REPAIR: Council crews are repairing damaged roads due to recent flood events. Motorists are urged to drive to conditions and obey traffic signals in place whilst the repairs are being undertaken.

The program supports the implementation of small scale, local projects to increase road safety awareness and promote safer road use. Grants of up to \$5,000 and \$30,000 are available for road safety projects that involve education and/or community engagement activities. INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL: Council is in receipt of a development application and accompanying documentation for the following development. DA No:2022/108 Land Description: Lot 4 Sec C DP4840 85 Gundagai Road, Cootamundra. Applicant: R.J. Sinclair Pty Limited Consent Authority: Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council. Description of Development: Construction and operation of an Unmanned Service Station and continued use of site as transport depot. The proposed development is Integrated Development under Section 4.46 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979 and the following approvals are required from those relevant approval bodies specified: *consent under Roads Act 1993 – s.138 *concurrence under SEPP (Transport & Infrastructure) 2021, s2.122 traffic generating development. All correspondence should be addressed to the General Manager of Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council and the above DA Reference number shall be included on such correspondence. If a submission is made by way of objection, the reasons for the objection must be outlined in the submission. It should be noted that information included in submissions received regarding the proposal may be used in public reports and can be accessed under the Government Information (Public Access) Act (GIPA), 2009. Section 10.4 of the Environmental Planning Assessment Act, 1979 and the Local Government and the Planning Legislation Amendment (Political Donations) Act, 2008 requires the disclosure of any reportable political donations or gifts by a person or persons who makes a relevant planning application to Council or submission on a relevant planning application to Council.
