



ORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY 27 SEPTEMBER 2022. GUNDAGAI COUNCIL CHAMBERS COMMENCING & LIVESTREAMED FROM 6PM.

ITEMS ON PUBLIC EXHIBITION: At the ordinary meeting held on Tuesday 23 August 2022, Council endorsed recommendations to place on public exhibition two reports for a period of 28 days: 1. HAS YOUR COMPANION ANIMAL JUST HAD A LITTER? ARE YOU SELLING OR GIVING AWAY PUPPIES OR KITTENS? Do you know what your responsibilities are? All cats and dogs being sold or given away must be microchipped, this includes working dogs. The microchip can only be implanted by an Authorised person and this microchip number must be included in all advertising when selling or giving away Puppies or Kittens. Which includes ads on Gumtree, Facebook, notice boards in shops and in newspapers. It is the responsibility of the owner/breeder to change the puppy or kittens' details over into the new owner's name. There are forms you should complete called a "Change of Owner" form. Available from Council or download them from the NSW Pet Registry website - <https://www.petregistry.nsw.gov.au/#/forms> The Companion Animal "Change of Owner" forms have three copies: Yellow copy – Sent / Handed into the Council. White copy – Kept by the old Owner/Breeder, must be kept for 2 years. Pink copy – Given to the new Owner of the puppy or kitten. Council staff can assist you if you need any help.

Description of Development: Construction and operation of an Unmanned Service Station and continued use of site as transport depot. The proposed development is Integrated Development under Section 4.46 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979 and the following approvals are required from those relevant approval bodies specified: *consent under Roads Act 1993 – s.138 *concurrence under SEPP (Transport & Infrastructure) 2021, s2.122 traffic generating development. If a submission is made by way of objection, the reasons for the objection must be outlined in the submission. It should be noted that information included in submissions received regarding the proposal may be used in public reports and can be accessed under the Government Information (Public Access) Act (GIPA), 2009. Section 10.4 of the Environmental Planning Assessment Act, 1979 and the Local Government and the Planning Legislation Amendment (Political Donations) Act, 2008 requires the disclosure of any reportable political donations or gifts by a person or persons who makes a relevant planning application to Council or submission on a relevant planning application to Council.
