**SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS ON TIMBER RAIL VIADUCT OI BELL DRIVE GUNDAGAI:** Transport for NSW will carry out maintenance and safety improvement work to the timber rail viaduct in Gundagai. Work will be carried out on sections of the viaduct along OI Bell Drive and Middleton Drive to improve safety for transport customers. Recent heavy rainfall and flooding has caused sections of the historic bridge to deteriorate. The work will reduce the risk of falling debris and allow vehicles and pedestrians to safely travel under the bridge. Traffic changes along OI Bell Drive will be in place for the duration of the work. Stop signs at either side of the underpass on OI Bell Drive have been installed with other signage advising transport customers of potential falling debris. Transport is working quickly and in consultation with Council to carry out this work.
