TENDER OPEN SHERIDAN STREET GUNDAGAI MAIN STREET **UPGRADE:** CGRC is seeking suitably qualified contractors to complete the Sheridan St Main St Upgrade (Block 3 Stage 2) from Homer St 120m easterly towards Virgil Street on the Southern side in Gundagai. The works have been compiled into six (6) construction packages. Respondents are invited to submit a quotation for one or all packages listed. There will be no further breakdown within each package. \*Demolition and Bulk Earthworks \*Water + Stormwater Drainage \*Construction of Retaining Walls \*Kerb and Gutter Construction \*Footpath - Concrete Subgrade and Stencilled Concrete Footpaths \*Footpath Stone Paving \*Road Pavement Construction. Tenders close Monday 13 February 2023 at 2pm. <u>VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:</u> Cootamundra's Bradman Cottage and the Cootamundra Heritage Centre are looking for volunteers. Volunteering can be on a weekly, fortnightly, or monthly basis and expands social networks, provides new skills and makes a difference to your community.

REHABILITATION PROJECT - COOPER LANE COOTAMUNDRA: Residents and motorists are advised that rehabilitation works will commence on Cooper Lane Cootamundra from 6 February 2023 until April 2023. During this time the lane will be closed to traffic periodically. Please obey traffic signals in area whilst these works are underway.

PUBLIC SPACES (UNATTENDED PROPERY)-VEHICLES: The NSW Government have introduced new laws, involving motor vehicles, caravans, boat and other trailers and cars, this is the Public Spaces (Unattended Property) Act 2021 and Regulations. The new laws enables Councils to remove any of these items that are causing an obstruction to a road user or pedestrian, or that is a potential safety risk and is impacting on the environment and the enjoyment of our Public Spaces. This law puts the accountability firmly on those responsible to manage their own vehicles/items and to do the right thing and remove their property quickly from public land. CGRC's Rangers will be commencing compliance checks from February and will be largely concentrating their patrols on the townships of Cootamundra and Gundagai, checking for vehicles/items that have been left parked on Public Spaces for too long. The Council will notify the owners that their Vehicle, Caravan, Boat, or other Trailer is causing a safety risk or an obstruction and is to be moved off the road and onto their property. HEAVY PATCHING PROGRAM: Council has commenced the heavy patching program on the Olympic Highway at the Junee boundary and will progress over the next 2-3 weeks to the Hilltops boundary north of Wallendbeen, before moving onto Burley Griffin Way for another 2-3 weeks. These works are fully funded by TfNSW and managed by CGRC and will serve to improve our state road network. Please obey traffic signals and drive with care!
