

The Drop-In Centre is located in Parker Street Cootamundra and is a wonderful facility for Veterans to take part in activities, or just pop in and have a chat. busy road. \$4.2 million has been secured to


undertake extensive infrastructure works.

People wishing to address Council are asked to submit a Speaker Registration Form well in advance of the meeting. Council meetings are to be conducted in accordance with the Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council Code of Meeting Practice, the Code.

Amongst other things, the Code specifies that no more than two (2) speakers are permitted to speak 'for' or 'against' any item of business on the agenda. If there are more than two (2) speakers proposed on any one topic a process will need to be applied to ensure proceeding are orderly.
