**OLYMPIC HIGHWAY ROAD WORKS:** Council wishes to advise of Shoulder Widening and Culvert Replacement works commencing Mid-May on Olympic Highway just south of Cootamundra, finishing just north of Wallendbeen. These works will continue to the end of 2023. Works are to widen narrow culverts and shoulders as a safety improvement for motorists along this area, resulting from safety surveys performed by TfNSW. Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council are coordinating and overseeing works on behalf of TfNSW. Works are fully funded by TfNSW. Motorists are asked to remain vigilant to workers along the roadside where short delays are expected. Traffic will be under full traffic management in work areas. **REDUCED SPEED LIMIT TEMORA STREET & BOUNDARY ROAD COOTAMUNDRA:**

Transport for NSW will reduce the speed limit on Temora Street and Boundary Road to 80 km/h and extend the existing 50 km/h transition. The existing 50 km/h transition on Temora Street will be extended 183 metres northwest to the Temora Bridge. The speed limit will be reduced from 100 km/h to 80 km/h from Temora Bridge for two kilometres northwest, to the southern side of Barana Road. The 50 km/h transition on Boundary Road will be extended 143 metres north. The current speed limit of 100 km/h will be reduced to 80 km/h from the new 50 km/h transition to the Temora Street intersection. The new speed zone will come into effect on Wednesday 3 May, weather permitting. Motorists are reminded to drive to the sign posted speed limit at all times.

**CGRC ROADS GO LIVE ON LIVE TRAFFIC NSW:** Motorists will now be able to check on road networks within the LGA via TfNSW Live Traffic App. Council Road conditions will now be uploaded to Live Traffic NSW, giving the community up to date information when driving on local, regional, and state roads with our Council area.
