ROAD WORKS TO COMMENCE – FRENCH STREET

COOTAMUNDRA: Council will commence rehabilitation works at French St Cootamundra, from Monday 22 May 2023. The work will require at times, full road closures. Residents will be notified. The rehabilitation work is funded by the Fixing Local Roads Program and is expected to be completed in July (weather permitting). This work will alleviate drainage issues that have caused extensive damage to French Street over the years. Motorists are asked to avoid using the street if possible, during the works and always obey traffic signals in place.

REDUCED SPEED LIMIT TEMORA STREET & BOUNDARY ROAD

COOTAMUNDRA: Transport for NSW will reduce the speed limit on Temora Street and Boundary Road to 80 km/h and extend the existing 50 km/h transition. The new speed zone will come into effect on Wednesday 3 May, weather permitting. Motorists are reminded to drive to the sign posted speed limit at all times.
