Recently CGRC staff have undertaken the removal of shopping trolleys, tyres and other debris, found in the creek. Council staff have retrieved several trolleys and machinery will be required to remove several more located near the bridge in Wallendoon Street.

Abandoned shopping trolleys cause a build-up of debris and restrict water flow and incur a cost to Council for removal. The dumping of tyres in waterways restricts the flow of water and causes harmful effects on the environment and wildlife. Tiny particles from the tyres will flake and shed impacting organisms and wildlife habitat. Materials from tyres include synthetic rubber, filling agents, oils and other additives. Large fines can be issued for the dumping of rubbish in waterways.

COMPANION ANIMAL AUDIT: CGRC will be undertaking an audit of the NSW Companion Animal Register of cats and dogs over the coming 8-10 weeks that are currently unregistered. Microchip Identification and Lifetime Registration greatly assist the Council in returning your pet if they are lost, hurt, or stolen. Under the NSW Companion Animals Act 1998, cat and dog owners must undertake two steps to provide their pet with lifetime protection: 1. Permanent Microchip Identification and 2. Lifetime Registration. All pets in NSW, must be registered by 6 months of age, including all working dog. Registration fee is a oneoff payment, paid at Council Offices and covers your pet for its lifetime, regardless of any changes in ownership. Owners are responsible for changing details when pets are sold or given away. If your pet has died, you must also notify the Council within 28 days of its death.
