**COMPANION ANIMAL AUDIT:** CGRC will be undertaking an audit of the NSW Companion Animal Register of cats and dogs over the coming 8-10 weeks that are currently unregistered.

Under the NSW Companion Animals Act 1998, cat and dog owners must undertake two steps to provide their pet with lifetime protection: 1 Permanent Microchip Identification and 2 Lifetime Registration.

All cats and dogs in NSW, must be registered by 6 months of age, including working dogs. Registration fee is a one-off payment, paid at Council Offices and covers your pet for its lifetime, regardless of any changes in ownership. Owners are responsible for changing details when pets are sold or given away. If your pet has died, you must also notify the Council within 28 days of its death.
