## <u>Changed traffic conditions on Olympic Highway near Cootamundra and Wallendbeen</u>

Motorists are advised of changed traffic conditions from next week on the Olympic Highway near Cootamundra and Wallendbeen for safety improvement work.

Single lane closures on the Olympic Highway will be in place seven kilometers south of Cootamundra between Frampton and Dirnaseer roads, and three kilometres south of Wallendbeen between Wallendoon Lane and Cullinga Road.

Work involves removing trees, improving drainage, widening shoulders and installing safety barriers to provide a safer road for transport customers.

Work will be carried out between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday, from Monday 15 May and is expected to take eight weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Single lane closure, traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place for the safety of workers and road users.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, allow an extra five minutes travel time, and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
