

Wallendbeen Bridge project community drop-in session

Notification letter – June 2023

What is happening

Work started on the permanent road over rail bridge on the Burley Griffin Way at Wallendbeen late last year, following the removal of the old bridge after damage was sustained during a significant rain event. The new bridge will improve travel times and provide an improved structure with wider two-lane crossing for transport customers.

To complete this project, Transport for NSW has been in complex negotiations with the rail infrastructure manager responsible for the relevant section of the rail corridor for several months. Planning, preparation and enabling work has been progressing while we coordinate re-starting work on-site in the coming months. We will let you know as soon as we have more information.

Accessing rail corridors explained

Carrying out construction within a live rail corridor requires a collaborative approach between Transport and the rail infrastructure manager to ensure safety for the community, workers, trains and transport customers.

When completing major work within the rail corridor, trains cannot run. To facilitate this a “possession” is required. There is one more possession expected for this corridor in 2023, which is later in the year. This is several months later than Transport had originally anticipated. We are doing all we can to complete work as quickly as possible.

We apologise for this unexpected delay and will keep the community updated on progress and the new completion date.

Transport thanks the community for its patience and understanding while we complete this important project.
