BE A RESPONSIBLE PET OWNER: A reminder that under the NSW Companion Animals Act, **dogs must be kept on a leash in all public places.** Except in designated off leash parks. Owners caught with dogs off leash may be issued with penalty infringement notice of \$330.

Pet owners are reminded to clean up after your dog. Disposable bags are available across most parks and public places, and dog walkers are encouraged to always have the bags with them. A hefty \$275 fine can be incurred for failing to immediately dispose of faeces. Enquires can be made by calling Council on 1300 459 689.
