OLYMPIC HWY WORKS: Culvert replacement works continuing Olympic Highway south of Wallendbeen. Under full traffic management. Expect short delays. Reduced speeds overnight in immediate work areas. Hazardous tree trimming works on Olympic Highway from Wallendbeen to Junee boundary. Under full traffic control. Expect short delays. Both projects managed by Council and funded by TfNSW. Remain mindful of pavement defects (potholes, loose surface etc) as a consequence of on-going wet weather on Burley Griffin Way and Olympic Highway.

CYCLEWAY SURVEY NOW AVAILABLE: Residents are invited to participate in the Cycleway Survey now online via the Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council's website and Facebook page. The survey will determine where the community wants to see destinations that can be accessed by cycleways. BE A RESPONSIBLE PET OWNER: A reminder that under the NSW Companion Animals Act, **dogs must be kept on a leash in all public places.** Except in designated off leash parks. Owners caught with dogs off leash may be issued with penalty infringement notice of \$330. **Pet owners are reminded to clean up** after your dog. Disposable bags are available across most parks and public places, and dog walkers are encouraged to always have the bags with them. A hefty \$275 fine can be incurred for failing to immediately dispose of faeces. Enquires can be made by calling Council on 1300 459 689.

WEST & PUNCH STREET PAVEMENT WORKS: Are continuing from drainage works into pavement works on this intersection. A detour will be in place via Bourke & Hanley Streets. Proceed with caution and follow traffic signals and signage in place.
