PIONEER PARK MAKEOVER:

Cootamundra's Pioneer Park redevelopment is nearing completion with the inclusion of a new free camping area, barbeques, toilet block and fire pits. The project should be completed by the end of August pending favourable weather conditions. The major component of the project consists of developing and adding to existing infrastructure, the sites significance and enhancement of the heritage value of the site. This will benefit local flora and fauna, the community, and visitors alike. the imminent closure of the National Australia Bank (NAB) in Gundagai and have written to the NAB Bank & relevant Government ministers voicing concerns. I urge members of the community to write to our local parliamentary members (both state and federal), to voice your concerns. We are continuing to see much need improvements and redevelopments across our communities' facilities. I'm also pleased that the Muttama Hall kitchen has been installed and turf laying completed at Gundagai's Lindley
