OLYMPIC HIGHWAY & BURLEY GRIFFIN WAY ROAD WORKS:

Shoulder widening works progressing on Olympic Highway, south of Wallendbeen for the next 3-4 weeks under full traffic management. Aftercare will be in place, reducing speeds to 60Km/h.

Annual heavy patching works are scheduled to commence mid-September on Olympic Highway and Burley Griffin Way to improve pavement condition. Works will progress under full traffic management. These works are fully funded by TfNSW and managed by Council.

Motorists are also asked to follow rough road advisory warnings when present, adhere to reduced speeds to improve safety in these areas.
