2023:

CGRC held two events during LG Week to showcase the services Council brings to our communities. The events held in Cootamundra and Gundagai saw residents and visitors enjoying a sausage sizzle, and a mini expo of giveaways and information. Road Safety information, along with tourism brochures and a host of other material was available. Staff and Councillors were on hand to talk to visitors. Two large machines were popular.

REPAIRS TO STOP LEAKS AT GUNDAGAI POOL:

Major repairs to Gundagai Pool have been completed. A significant crack in the return channel of the pool has been sealed with an epoxy bandage system designed for repairing leaks in ageing swimming pools and an aluminium plate installed to ensure the underpool surface remains watertight. This work was undertaken with grant funding and the pool will be ready for use in the upcoming season. (Pictured below).



SPECTACULAR VIEWS FROM PIONEER PARK:

Residents and visitors to Cootamundra's Pioneer Park can now enjoy a little respite and a spectacular view from the park benches installed on the walking track to the summits. (Pictured above).

The park has undergone some significant improvements of late.

Council will apply to have Tourist Attraction signposting in place directing road users to the newly designated recreational vehicle rest stop and camping ground established in the park.

PERMIT APPROVALS PAVE **WAY FOR CREEK CLEANUP:**

Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council has applied and been granted approval for permits to undertake works at council structures (e.g., causeways, bridges etc.) along Muttama Creek to remove vegetation and undertake excavation of some material within 10m upstream and downstream from the creek at specific locations. Undertaking this work will be

under strict permit approvals which include working at times of minimal water flow and with the placement of erosion and sediment protection measures. Council expects to commence work on and near the causeways at Hovell, Thompson, Poole Streets and

Cutler Avenue and the Mackay, Parker and Wallendoon Street bridges in the week beginning 28 August, subject to weather and creek flows.
