CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS ON OLYMPIC HIGHWAY BETWEEN COOTAMUNDRA AND YOUNG:

Motorists are advised of changed traffic conditions from next week on the Olympic Highway for drainage improvement work to be carried out between Cootamundra and Young. Single lane closures will be in place at three locations along the highway to provide a stronger and safer road for motorists. Work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm from Tuesday 22 August to Thursday 30 November, weather permitting. Work at one location will be finished before starting work at the next site, with each site to take about 3-4 weeks to finish, weather permitting.

Over size, over mass vehicles will be assisted through the site by traffic control. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
